LOCATION

The Ostomy Service is based on the Hawke's Bay Hospital site, at Wilson House, entrance via Gate 9, McLeod Street, Hastings.

WELCOME TO OUR SERVICE

This pamphlet aims to help you understand what the service can provide. If you are unsure about anything please ask any of our staff - they are here to help.

If required, we have an interpreter service available, this can be arranged through your Ostomy Nurse.

OSTOMY SERVICE STAFF INCLUDES

Registered Nurses who are experienced in stoma management, care associates and administration staff.

ROLE OF OSTOMY SERVICE REGISTERED NURSES

Pre-operative counselling and post-operative nursing assessment, management and education for those undergoing surgery, for diversion of urine or faeces, which results in stoma formation.

Prescription of consumables for patients.

Education and support for whānau/family and/or significant others.

Regular and/or two yearly assessment of patients.

Referral to other agencies and/or health professionals as required.

REFERRAL TO THE OSTOMY SERVICE IS BY

Written referral from a General Practitioner, Specialist Surgeon or other hospital based health professionals.

Transfer from another District Health Board following referral from the Stoma Nurse.

HOME VISITS

If the Nurse is visiting you at home, it is your responsibility to ensure safe access to the property, and that dogs are tied up/locked away for the visit.

You may be asked to attend a clinic at one of the Hawke's Bay District Health Board facilities.

TIME OF HOME VISIT

Home visits will be arranged between 8:30am and 4:00pm. A specific time for the visit can not be given as the service is also responsible for supporting hospital patients.

CANCELLATION

If you are not available on the day of your planned appointment, please phone the service immediately to allow for alternative arrangements or other patient appointments to be scheduled. Refer our Contact Details

CONSUMABLES

A Registered Nurse who specialises in stoma management will prescribe appropriate consumables for your use.

Once your prescription is confirmed, the service will arrange for the majority of your supplies to be delivered directly to your home.
