YOUR OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT (1982) REQUEST HBDHB REF: OIA2020066

I refer to your Official Information Act request, transferred in part by the Ministry of Health to Hawke's Bay District Health Board (HBDHB) on 8 May 2020. Your questions and HBDHB's response is provided below:

For the period 30 January 2020 to 30 April 2020

COVID-19 hospitalisation numbers by Māori with lived experience of disability (tāngata whaikaha) and non-Māori with lived experience of disability.

Hawke's Bay DHB is not able to provide a breakdown on disability status of hospitalised patients as this information is not routinely collected. For the period requested three patients were hospitalised with COVID; one identifies as Māori.

COVID-19 mortality numbers by Māori with lived experience of disability (tāngata whaikaha) and non-Māori with lived experience of disability.

Nil, Hawke's Bay DHB has reported no COVID-19 deaths.
