I refer to your Official Information Act request partially transferred to district health boards by the Ministry of Health on 17 September 2021 where you requested information from Hawke's Bay District Health Board (HBDHB). Your questions and HBDHB's response is provided below:

"details on how District Health Boards are freeing up ICU beds. In particular, can you advise: b) To what extent is contracting out elective surgery to the private sector being increased?"

The DHB has interpreted your request as relating to day-to-day demand management – i.e. reducing demand to free-up specialist services.

Hawke's Bay District Health Board does not contract out elective surgery for the purposes of freeing up ICU bed capacity.
