## **YOUR OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT (1982) REQUEST HBDHB REF: OIA2021150**

I refer to your Official Information Act request dated 11 November 2021 where you requested information from Hawke's Bay District Health Board (HBDHB). Your questions and HBDHB's response is provided below:

### **1-Myocarditis cases (overall)**

**The total number of myocarditis cases recorded by your DHB in 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021(YTD). Please break this year by year, by age, and by gender in the following way:**

- **All cases recorded in men, broken down in the following age brackets, for each individual year: (0-9, 10-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70-79, 80-89, 90+)**
- **All cases recorded in women, broken down in the same age brackets, for each individual year.**

### **2-Myocarditis cases (month by month)**

**The total number of myocarditis cases recorded by your DHB between February and November 2021. This is to match the vaccine roll-out. Please break this down month by month, by age and by gender in the same way as above, ie:**

- **All cases recorded in men, broken down in the following age brackets, for each individual month: (0-9, 10-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70-79, 80-89, 90+)**
- **All cases recorded in women, broken down in the same age brackets, for each individual month.**

### **3-Pericarditis cases (overall)**

- **The total number of second vaccine doses given to women, broken down in the same age brackets, for each individual month.**

The information you request is more closely connected to information held by the Ministry of Health. Therefore under section 14 (b)(ii) of the Official Information Act 1982, relating to information being more closely connected with the function of another department, the DHB declines your request.

Hawke's Bay DHB understands the Ministry of Health has invited you to engage with it on a rescoped request.
