Improving the health of Māori people throughout Hawke's Bay is a key aim of the Hawke's Bay District Health Board. As well as specific services for Māori, the Hawke's Bay District Health Board is committed to providing treatment and care that is both accessible and culturally acceptable to Māori. To achieve this, a number of our services have designated Māori positions, to ensure specific services are provided for Māori, by Māori and in addition the organisation is committed to ensuring all staff are culturally competent to respond to Māori appropriately.

Hawke's Bay District Health Board recognises tikanga Māori values as being key to Māori health outcomes that are appropriate, accessible and affordable. At the heart of Hawke's Bay District Health Board's Māori Health Service, is Te Wahanga Hauora Māori (the Māori Health Service) and Whare Mihiroa, just off Omahu Road. In addition we fund five Maori health providers in the community who deliver good quality clinical and non-clinical services from Wairoa to Takapau.

Te Wahanga Hauora Māori is open until 10 pm from Wednesday to Monday every week and until 5pm on Tuesdays and Wednesdays and provides and supports a wide range of services. In addition there is a seven day a week on call service easily accessible through the hospital duty manager. If you need support or advice, call in and see the friendly team who will be able to help you or direct you to the appropriate service.

Our commitment to the Treaty of Waitangi and the underlying values contained in Tikanga Māori is reflected in our services and practices, staff working environments and in the way clients receive treatment and care.



Over an eight week programme Springhill clinical staff conducts therapeutic interventions, group work and counselling. Residents attend local Alcoholic or Narcotic Anonymous Groups off-site. Support and education is also provided to resident's family.

The Springhill programme encourages residents to consider others on a day to day basis as they share meals, rooms and life experience. We provide a safe structured environment in which to accept responsibilities and practice the disciplines of a healthy lifestyle.
